

Sweet 16 Bonus Blackjack Rules of Play

Sweet 16 Bonus Blackjack is an optional side wager for standard Blackjack games played with 2, 6 or 8 standard 52-card decks.

To begin, players may place the Sweet 16 Bonus side wager, before any cards are dealt. The wager is resolved based on three cards, the first two-player cards, and the dealer's face-up card. If the cards satisfy one of the eligible scenarios, the wager wins and pays according to the highest eligible scenario, according to the payable below:

1. Suited A-2-3	---	100 to 1
2. Any three A-A-A	---	50 to 1
3. Unsuited A-2-3	---	30 to 1
4. Queen and 6 of hearts	---	10 to 1
5. Any Queen and 6	---	5 to 1
6. 16 Total	---	3 to 1
7. 15 Total	---	2 to 1
8. 14 Total	---	1 to 1

The following notes explain further some of the scenarios listed above.

- **Suited A-2-3 and Unsuited A-2-3:** One of the three cards must be an Ace, one must be a Two, and one must be a Three. It does not matter whether the Ace, Two, or Three is held by the player or the dealer.
- **Player 16 Total, Player 15 Total, and Player 14 Total:** The player cards must sum to 16, 15, or 14 respectively, with Aces having a value of 11 or 1.
