

## **The Cosmopolitan of Las Vegas Roulette Rules**

The Cosmopolitan of Las Vegas Roulette is a variation of Roulette played with a 39-spot wheel, consisting of the numbers 1-36, 0, 00, and a non-numerical 39<sup>th</sup> spot. The 39<sup>th</sup> spot, like 0 or 00, counts as neither red nor black, nor odd, nor even. The 39<sup>th</sup> spot will have "C" that is reflective to The Cosmopolitan of Las Vegas.

To begin, players place their wagers on the appropriate betting locations on the layout. The game is otherwise played in the same manner as Roulette.

The pay schedule is as follows:

- **Straight Up:** ball lands on one chosen number and pays 35 to 1
- **Split:** ball lands on one of two adjacent chosen numbers and pays 17 to 1
- **Street:** ball lands on one of three chosen numbers in a row and pays 11 to 1
- **Corner:** ball lands on one of four chosen numbers that meet at one corner and pays 8 to 1
- **Top Line:** ball lands on one of five chosen numbers (0, 00, 1, 2, 3) and pays 6 to 1
- **Line:** ball lands on one of six chosen numbers that are in two adjacent rows and pays 5 to 1
- **Dozen:** ball lands on one of 12 chosen numbers in a section and pays 2 to 1
- **Column:** ball lands on one of 12 chosen numbers in a column and pays 2 to 1
- **Red:** ball lands on one of 18 red numbers and pays 1 to 1
- **Black:** ball lands on one of 18 black numbers and pays 1 to 1
- **Odd:** ball lands on one of 18 odd numbers and pays 1 to 1
- **Even:** ball lands on one of 18 even numbers and pays 1 to 1
- **1 to 18:** ball lands on one number of the first 18 numbers and pays 1 to 1
- **19 to 36:** ball lands on one number of the second 18 numbers and pays 1 to 1

The Cosmopolitan of Las Vegas "C" logo (39<sup>th</sup> pocket) can be wagered with the following betting options:

- **Straight Up on "C"** pays 35 to 1
- **Split with 0 or 00** pays 17 to 1
- **Street "C", 0, and 00** pays 11 to 1

"Green Outside" covers 0, 00, and "C" and pays 11 to 1.

"Courtesy Line" 0 and 00 only and pays 17 to 1.
