

THREE CARD PRIME

Three Card Prime is played using a standard 52-card deck of cards. To begin, players must make a mandatory Ante wager to receive three cards which are used to form a higher poker hand than the dealer's three cards. Additionally, players may place any optional side wagers made available.

The Mini-Royal Progressive is an optional side bet. Players are paid against a payable if they are able to create a qualifying hand with their three hole cards.

Outcome	\$1 Wager	\$5 Wager
Mini Royal (Suit Specific)	100% of Progressive	100% of Progressive
Mini Royal (Other)	\$500	\$2500
Straight Flush	\$75	\$375
Three of a Kind	\$50	\$250
Straight	\$5	\$25

Notes:

1. Only the highest qualifying hand is paid.
2. The highest result in the payable awards 100% of the progressive.
3. Operators may choose to post a maximum aggregate.
4. Operators may choose to offer Three Card Prime with or without this wager.
5. All pays are "X for 1."
6. Mini Royal (Suit Specific) means the player's Mini Royal hand must be of a predetermined specific suit. Mini Royal hands of other suits are awarded the Mini Royal (Other) payout.
7. If the progressive is configured with a different wager amount, all seed/reseed values and player pays should be multiplied accordingly.

ALL 6 BONUS

The All 6 Bonus is an optional side bet. Players are paid against a payable if they are able to create a qualifying hand that uses the player's three hole cards combined with the dealer's three cards. Otherwise, the All 6 Bonus side bet is lost.

Straight	10	10
Three of a Kind	5	5

Notes:

1. Only the highest qualifying hand is paid.
2. Operators may choose to post a maximum aggregate.
3. The top two awards on Paytables 6 & 7 are fixed pays.
4. Operators may choose to offer Three Card Prime with or without this wager.

All other aspects of the standard game of Three Card Prime remain unchanged.
