

THREE CARD PRIME

Three Card Prime is played using a standard 52-card deck of cards. To begin, players must make a mandatory Ante wager to receive three cards which are used to form a higher poker hand than the dealer's three cards. Additionally, players may place any optional side wagers made available.

The Mini-Royal Progressive is an optional side bet. Players are paid against a payable if they are able to create a qualifying hand with their three hole-cards. If the player's hand forms a Straight or higher, the Mini Royal Progressive bet wins and pays according to the payable. Otherwise, the bet loses. Additionally, paytables PT-BJS-TCPR-E01 or PT-BJS-TCPR-E02 may also award a fixed Envy pay to other wagering players. To qualify for an Envy pay, at least one player must have a Mini Royal. All other players who have placed the Mini Royal Progressive wager but do not have a Mini Royal hand will receive the listed Envy pay.

Notes:

1. Only the highest qualifying hand is paid.
2. The highest result in the payable awards 100% of the progressive.
3. Operators may choose to post a maximum aggregate.
4. Operators may choose to offer Three Card Prime with or without this wager.
5. If the progressive is configured with a different wager amount, all seed/reseed values, player pays, and Envy pays should be multiplied accordingly.

All other aspects of the standard game of Three Card Prime remain unchanged.
