



RULES OF PLAY

1. TriLux Supreme is two optional bonus bets for blackjack; TriLux Deluxe and TriLux Runner.
2. TriLux Deluxe considers the first two cards the player receives and the dealer's up card. If a player receives a Flush or better they will win. See payable for odds.
3. TriLux Runner considers the total number of cards it takes the dealer to bust or draw out to 17 or better.
4. To begin each round, players must make their standard blackjack wagers. They may also make the TriLux Deluxe and/or TriLux Runner wager.
5. The dealer then follows house procedures for blackjack.
6. Once players and the dealer have two cards, the dealer settles TriLux Deluxe wagers in one of two ways.
 - a. When the cards are dealt face up, the TriLux Deluxe wagers will be settled immediately after everyone receives their first two (2) cards and dealer's first two cards. Winning TriLux Deluxe bets will be paid and losing bets will be picked up in order of placement from the dealer's right to left. Then, standard blackjack play will resume.
 - b. When the cards are dealt face down, the TriLux Deluxe wagers will be settled on a hand to hand basis, as the dealer goes from left to right asking for hit/stand determinations.
7. If the player wins the TriLux Deluxe wager, they have the option to collect the proceeds from the winning side bet or they may ask the dealer to add all or a portion of the winnings to the TriLux Deluxe Press circle. The winnings moved to the TriLux Deluxe Press circle will be paid even money if the player wins their standard BJ wager or picked up if the player loses their standard BJ wager. All house double down and split rules that apply to the player's standard BJ wager also apply to the chips moved to the TriLux Deluxe Press circle.

Note:

- a. Winning TriLux Deluxe wagers are not eligible to be moved to the TriLux Deluxe Press circle if the dealer has Blackjack.
 - b. The player ISN'T allowed to touch their winning TriLux Deluxe chips. The dealer will move them for the player.
 - c. The Player has the option to have their winning TriLux Deluxe wager moved to the TriLux Deluxe Press circle if their winning hand is a Blackjack.
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8. Once all players have acted upon their hands, the dealer will play out their hand. If the dealer busts or draws out to 17 or better, in five or more cards, the TriLux Runner side bet will win. See layout for odds.
 9. The TriLux Runner also offers a Lucky George Dealer Envy payout that's paid directly to the dealer or the dealer's tip pool. See payable for payouts.
