## Ties Plus (Formerly Three Legged Frog)

## Rules of Play

Three Legged Frog is played using eight standard 52 card decks. The game is an optional side bet for standard Baccarat.

To begin, players will make a wager on the "Three Legged Frog' side bet. The game is then dealt and played in the same manner as traditional Baccarat (standard drawing rules apply to Player and Banker hands). The player wins if all cards in the Player and Banker hands result in a tie. If the result of the hand is not a tie, the "Three Legged Frog" side bet is a loss.

The "Three Legged Frog" side bet pays odds according to the paytables below.
