

Twenty Plus is a new side bet for blackjack. It is dealt from a single deck or a 6- or 8-deck shoe.

Rules of Play

In addition to the mandatory primary blackjack bet, the player has the option to make a two-card Twenty Plus side bet before any cards are dealt. The side bet is based on the player's first two cards, and its outcome is determined partially by the counting system for blackjack and partially by the poker ranking. The side bet wins if the player's first two cards can form a pair, a "blackjack" (an Ace and any 10-value card) or a 'Twenty' composed of any two of the four 10-value cards Tens, Jacks, Queens and Kings.

The pay tables are shown below:

Single Deck

All payouts are "to 1."

The outcome of the side bet has no bearing on the primary blackjack bet.
