Twisted 21

Rules of Play

Twisted 21 is a variation of the standard game of Blackjack. The game is played using a single deck of 52 cards. Twisted 21 gives Players the opportunity to pick from three hit cards dealt to them and offers optional Stud Bonus and Stud Poker side wagers.

To begin, Players must place the mandatory Twisted 21 wager. They may also make the optional Stud Bonus and/or Stud Poker side wagers. (operator's discretion to offer side wagers).

Each participating player receives two cards face-up and three cards face-down. The Dealer receives one card face-up and four cards face-down. Empty Player positions receive five face-down and discarded.

If the dealer has a natural Blackjack, all Players who also have a natural Blackjack will push their Twisted 21 wagers. All other Players will lose their Twisted 21 wager, and the Stud Poker round will begin (if applicable).

If the Dealer does not have a natural Blackjack, Players play against the Dealer according to the following rules:

- Dealer hits on soft total of 17.
- Blackjack pays 6 to 5.
- Players may not split pairs.
- Double Down is permitted.
- Both the Player and the Dealer must stand on un-busted five card hands.
- If a Player busts, their Twisted 21 wager is collected but their cards remain active for the Stud Poker and Stud Bonus side wagers (if made).
- The Player's hit cards are selected from the three face-down cards dealt with their hand. The Player indicates which of the hit cards they want by pointing to the desired card.
- As an alternate method of play, the Player's hit cards are delivered in sequential order from the three face-down cards. The Player will indicate when they want to hit by pointing or tapping the table near the location of the hit cards.

SIDE WAGERS

Stud Poker Side Wager

The Stud Poker round begins after the completion of the Twisted 21 game. The Stud Poker side wager pays even money if the Player's five card hand beats the Dealer's five card hand. The Dealer must qualify with a King or Better. If the Dealer does not qualify, the Player's wager is pushed. If both hands tie, the Stud Poker wager is pushed. If the Dealer's hand beats the Player's hand, the Stud Poker wager is lost.

Stud Bonus Side Wager

The Stud Bonus side wager wins if the Player's five card hand is a pair of Jacks or Better. The Player may also be awarded payouts if the sum of their five card hand is less than or equal to 16. The Stud Bonus side wager pays odds according to the pay table below.

Four-of-a-Kind	251
Full House	101
Flush	16
Straight	7
Three-of-a-Kind	5
Two Pair	4
One Pair, Jacks or Better	3
Twisted Stud- 16 or less	11

5 Card Low Ball Stud Bonus (optional version)

The 5 Card Low Ball Stud Bonus side wager wins if the Player's five card hand is a Queen High or lower. The 5 Card Low Ball Stud Bonus side wager pays odds according to the pay table below.

Player's Hand	Pay 1 (for 1)
7 High	41
8 High	26
9 High	11
Ten High	6
Jack High	4
Queen High	3

7 Card Stud Bonus (optional version)

The 7 Card Stud Bonus side wager wins if the Player's best five card hand including the use of 2 community cards is a three-of-a-kind or better. The 7 Card Stud Bonus side wager pays odds according to the pay table below.

Player's Hand	Pay 1 (for 1)
Royal Flush	251
Straight Flush	51
Four-of-a-Kind	26
Full House	11
Flush	9
Straight	4
Three-of-a-Kind	3

7 Card Low Ball Stud Bonus (optional version)

The 7 Card Stud Bonus side wager wins if the Player's best five card hand including the use of 2 community cards is a Ten High or Lower. The 7 Card Stud Bonus side wager pays odds according to the pay table below.

Player's Hand	Pay 1 (for 1)
7 High	16
8 High	7
9 High	5
Ten High	3

Note: If a 7 Card Stud Bonus side wager is offered, two additional cards will be dealt as community cards at the beginning of the round, after all player positions have received cards. The remainder of the deck is then discarded.
