

**Bermuda Blackjack** is a variation of blackjack developed by Hi & Lo Gaming. The game features ten optional side bets that allow the player to win up to 75 times their wager.

In addition to the betting spot for the regular blackjack bet there are ten betting circles numbered 1 through 10, respectively, for the side bets. The player must make the regular blackjack bet in order to make any of the side bets. Each number in the betting circles indicates the score the player must have on his first two cards in order to win. Aces through nines count as their value; tens and face cards count as 0.

For side bets 1 through 9, one of the player's first two cards must be a zero value card - a ten or a face card. For example, the player with a bet in betting circle 5 is betting that his first two cards will be a 0 value card and a 5. If neither of his first two cards is a 0 value card then even if the sum of the two cards is 5 (e.g., a 2 and a 3) the player still loses the bet. For side bet 10 the player's first two cards must be an Ace and a 9; any other combination is a loser.

Depending on the pay table used the winning side bets are paid as follows:

**Pay Table I**

<b>Side Bet</b>	<b>1 through 9</b>	<b>10</b>
<b>Pay</b>	16 to 1	70 to 1

**Pay Table II**

<b>Side Bet</b>	<b>1 through 9</b>	<b>10</b>
<b>Pay</b>	18 to 1	75 to 1

The game plays like regular blackjack after the dealer collects the losing side bets and pays the winning side bets.
