

Ultimate Texas Hold'em

Rules of Play

"Ultimate Texas Hold'em" is a house banked poker game played using one standard 52 card deck. The object of the game is for players and the dealer to obtain their best five card poker hand formed from seven cards. Ultimate Texas Hold'em also offers an optional side wager that pay odds against a posted payable.

To begin, players must make an Ante and Blind wager of equal amounts. They may also place an optional Trips side wager. The player and the dealer then receive two cards, dealt face down.

1. Players now have a choice:
 - a) Check; or
 - b) Make a Play bet 3x or 4x their Ante.
2. The first three community cards (Flop) are then dealt on the layout.
3. Players that have not yet made a Play bet have a choice:
 - a) Check; or
 - b) Make a Play bet 2x their Ante.
4. The dealer then places the final two community cards (turn and river) on the layout.
5. Players that have not yet made a Play bet have a choice:
 - a) Fold; or
 - b) Make a Play bet 1x their Ante.
6. The dealer then reveals his two hole cards and announces his five-card hand. The dealer needs a pair to qualify.
7. If the player's hand beats the dealer's, the Play and Ante bets win even money.
8. If the player's hand loses to the dealer, the Play, Ante and Blind bets lose.
9. If the player's hand ties the dealer, the Play, Ante and Blind bets push.
10. The Blind bet pays odds according to the payable below:

(Pays on Beating the Dealer)

Player's Hand	Blind Bonus Payouts
Royal Flush	500 to 1
Straight Flush	50 to 1
4-of-a-Kind	10 to 1
Full House	3 to 1
Flush	3 to 2
Straight	1 to 1
3-of-a-Kind or Lower	Push

11. If the dealer does not qualify, the player's Ante bet is returned. The players Blind and Play bets are resolved as stated above.

The Trips side wager wins if the player's five card hand has a three-of-a-kind or better. Players who make the Trips side wager are paid odds on their final hand, regardless of whether they beat the dealer or not. See paytables below:
