## **Venetian Roulette**

## Rules

Venetian Roulette is a variation of Standard Roulette and is played on a 39 pocket Roulette wheel.

To begin, players place their wagers on the appropriate betting locations on the layout. After the wheel is spun and the ball has landed in a pocket, the dealer will resolve all wagers as follows:

- Straight Up: ball lands on the one chosen number and pays 35 to 1.
- Split: ball lands on one of two adjacent chosen numbers and pays 17 to 1.
- Street: ball lands on one of three chosen numbers in a row (horizontal Line) and pays 11 to 1.
- Corner: ball lands on one of four chosen numbers that meet at one corner and pays 8 to 1
- Top Line: ball lands on one of five chosen numbers (1, 2, 3, 0 and 00) and pays 6 to 1
- Line: ball lands on one of six chosen numbers that are in two adjacent rows and pays 5 to 1
- Dozen: ball lands on one of 12 chosen numbers in a section and pays 2 to 1. (1st 12, 2nd 12 or 3rd 12)
- Column: ball lands on one of 12 chosen numbers in a column and pays 2 to 1
- Red: ball lands on one of 18 red numbers and pays 1 to 1
- Black: ball lands on one of 18 black numbers and pays 1 to 1
- Odd: ball lands on one of 18 odd numbers and pays 1 to 1
- Even: ball lands on one of 18 even numbers and pays 1 to 1
- 1 to 18: ball lands on one number of the first 18 numbers and pays 1 to 1 (1 through 18)
- 19 to 36: ball lands on one number of the second 18 numbers and pays 1 to 1 (19 through 36)

The "Venetian" logo (39<sup>th</sup> pocket) can be wagered with the following betting options: "Straight Up" on "Venetian" (35 to 1) "Split" with 0, 00 or both (17 to 1) and a "Street", "Venetian", 0 and 00 (11 to 1).

"Green Outside" pays 11 to 1 and covers "Single 0, Double 00 and Venetian".

"Courtesy Line" pays 17 to 1 and covers "Single 0 and Double 00" only.
