

World Poker Tour Heads Up Hold'em

World Poker Tour (WPT) Heads Up Hold'em is a Texas Hold'em variation played using a standard deck of 52 cards. To begin, players must make the mandatory Ante and Odds wagers, to receive two cards which are combined with five community cards. Players form their best five card poker hand against the dealer's five card poker hand. Additionally, players may place any optional side wagers made available.

WPT Heads Up Hold'em Progressive is an optional progressive side bet. Players are paid against a payable if they are able to create a qualifying hand that uses the player's two hole cards combined with the five-card community board.

Notes:

1. Only the highest qualifying hand is paid.
2. The highest result in the payable awards 100% of the progressive.
3. All pays are "X for 1."
4. Operators may choose to post a maximum aggregate.
5. Operators may choose to offer Head's Up Hold'em with or without this wager.
6. If the progressive is configured with a different wager amount, all seed/reseed values and pays should be multiplied accordingly.

All other aspects of the standard game of WPT Heads Up Hold'em remain unchanged.
