



*(Bring your dead hands back to life!!!)*

## **RULES**

Zombie Blackjack is played with six or eight standard 52 card decks. To begin, players must make the Zombie Blackjack wager. Each player and the dealer then receive two cards.

Play continues in standard Blackjack manner according to the following rules:

Dealer hits Soft 17.

Blackjacks pay 3:2 or 6:5, except against dealer Blackjacks.

Players may split a pair of aces only once or up to three times (maximum four hands).

Players may split any other pair up to three times (maximum four hands).

Players receive only one card for each split ace.

Players can double down on any two card hand, including after splitting any pair except aces.

No surrender offered.

If dealer shows up-card of 2 – 6 and the player busts then the wager is lost.

If dealer shows up-card of 7 – Ace and the player busts then the player's bust cards are 'boxed' (squared up to form a neat pile) and the wager placed on top.

If the dealer's final hand total is 17 – 21 then any 'boxed wagers' are collected and the remaining wagers are settled per standard Blackjack procedures.

If the dealer's final hand total is 22 then any 'boxed wagers' are collected and the remaining wagers push (except player 'Blackjacks' which still get paid).

If the dealer's final hand total is 23 – 26, any applicable 'boxed wagers' and Zombie Blackjack wagers are paid at 1:1.

Note: If the dealer shows an Ace up-card then 'Insurance' is offered as in standard Blackjack. Double down and split hand wagers also qualify to become 'boxed wagers.'
