12 On January 23, 2020 the Nevada Gaming Commission entered the parties'
13 stipulation staying the above-captioned disciplinary action pending Respondent Stephen
14 Alan Wynn's district-court writ petition. The stipulation contemplated that if this action
15 returned to the Commission, Wynn would have 20 days to answer the Nevada Gaming
16 Control Board's complaint.

17 The district court dismissed without prejudice Wynn's petition on June 3, 2022. The
18 Board filed and served notice of the entry of the order on June 6, 2022, and the Commission
19 filed and served notice on June 8, 2022. The Commission therefore finds and concludes that
20 the stay should be lifted so that this action may proceed.

21 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the stay of proceedings is **LIFTED**.
