STIPULATION FOR SETTLEMENT AND ORDER

The State of Nevada, on relation of its NEVADA GAMING CONTROL BOARD (BOARD), filed and served a Complaint in NGC Case No. 20-01 against SAM-WILL, INC., dba FREMONT HOTEL AND CASINO (FREMONT), RESPONDENT herein, alleging certain violations of the Nevada Gaming Control Act and Regulations of the Nevada Gaming Commission (Commission or NGC).

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED to by the BOARD and RESPONDENT that the Complaint, NGC Case No. 20-01, filed against RESPONDENT in the above-entitled case, shall be settled on the following terms and conditions:

- 1. RESPONDENT does not admit the allegations or characterizations set forth in the Complaint, NGC Case No. 20-01. However, RESPONDENT admits and acknowledges that the Commission could determine from the allegations set forth in the Complaint, NGC Case No. 20-01, that violations of the Nevada Gaming Control Act or NGC Regulations occurred.
- 2. RESPONDENT fully understands and voluntarily waives the right to a public hearing on the charges and allegations set forth in the Complaint, the right to present and

cross-examine witnesses, the right to a written decision on the merits of the Complaint, and the right to obtain judicial review of the Commission's decision.

- RESPONDENT agrees to pay a fine in the amount of THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$300,000.00) electronically transferred to the State of Nevada-Nevada Gaming Commission on or before the date this Stipulation for Settlement and Order (Stipulation for Settlement) is accepted by the Commission. Said payment shall be made by a method of electronic payment approved by the Tax and License Division of the BOARD pursuant to NRS 353.1467. Interest on the fine shall accrue pursuant to NRS 17.130 on any unpaid balance computed from the date the payment is due until payment of the fine, and any accrued interest, is made in full.
- In consideration for the execution of this Stipulation for Settlement, RESPONDENT for itself, its heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby releases and forever discharges the State of Nevada, the Commission, the BOARD, the Nevada Attorney General, and each of their members, agents, and employees, in their individual and representative capacities, from any and all manner of actions, causes of action, suits, debts, judgments, execution, claims, and demands whatsoever, known or unknown, in law and equity, that RESPONDENT ever had, now has, may have, or claims to have against any and all of the persons or entities named in this paragraph arising out of, or by reason of, the investigation of the allegations of the Complaint filed in this disciplinary action, NGC Case No. 20-01, or any matter relating thereto.
- In further consideration for the execution of this Stipulation for Settlement, RESPONDENT hereby indemnifies and holds harmless the State of Nevada, the Commission, the BOARD, the Nevada Attorney General, and each of their members, agents, and employees, in their individual and representative capacities, from any and all claims, suits, and actions brought against the persons named in this paragraph by reason of the investigation of the allegations in the Complaint filed in this disciplinary action, NGC Case No. 20-01, and all other matters relating thereto, and against any and all expenses, damages, charges, and costs, including court costs and attorney fees, which have

been or may be sustained by the persons and entities named in this paragraph as a result of said claims, suits, and actions.

- 6. RESPONDENT enters into this Stipulation for Settlement freely and voluntarily and acknowledges that this Stipulation for Settlement is not the product of force, threats, or any other form of coercion or duress, but is the product of discussions between RESPONDENT and the attorney for the BOARD.
- 7. RESPONDENT and the BOARD acknowledge that this Stipulation for Settlement is made to avoid litigation and economize resources.
- 8. RESPONDENT and the BOARD recognize and agree that the Commission has the sole and absolute discretion to determine whether to accept this Stipulation for Settlement.
- 9. RESPONDENT and the BOARD hereby waive any right they may have to challenge the impartiality of the Commission to hear the above-entitled case on the matters embraced in the Complaint, NGC Case No. 20-01, if the Commission determines not to accept this Stipulation for Settlement.
- 10. RESPONDENT and the BOARD agree and understand that if the Commission does not accept this Stipulation for Settlement, it shall be withdrawn as null and void and RESPONDENT'S admissions, if any, that certain violations of the Nevada Gaming Control Act or the regulations adopted thereunder had occurred shall be withdrawn.
- 11. RESPONDENT and the BOARD agree and understand that this Stipulation for Settlement is intended to operate as full and final settlement of the Complaint filed against RESPONDENT in the above-entitled disciplinary case, NGC Case No. 20-01.
- 12. RESPONDENT and the BOARD agree and understand that any oral representations are superseded by this Stipulation for Settlement and that only those terms memorialized in writing herein shall be effective.
- 13. RESPONDENT agrees and understands that, although this Stipulation for Settlement, if approved by the Commission, will settle the Complaint filed in the above-entitled disciplinary case, NGC Case No. 20-01, the allegations contained in the Complaint
