**ORDER TO STAY RESPONDENTS'
SUBPOENA DUCES TECUM AND
ORDER TO MEET AND CONFER ON
STADIUM TECHNOLOGY'S MOTION
FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER**

13 On January 12, 2022, the parties in the above-captioned case stipulated to a
14 discovery plan and scheduling order, wherein they agreed to complete discovery by April
15 30, 2022. On March 30, 2022, non-party Stadium Technology Group, LLC (Stadium
16 Technology) filed a Motion for Protective Order Concerning Respondents' Subpoena Duces
17 Tecum and Deposition Subpoena (Motion) pursuant to Nevada Gaming Commission (NGC
18 or Commission) Regulation 7.120. The Motion requests the subpoenas be quashed for lack
19 of proper service, requiring the production of documents prior to a hearing, and for being
20 overbroad and unduly burdensome. Mot. at 4. Stadium Technology was to comply with the
21 Subpoena Duces Tecum by March 30, 2022, and a deposition is currently scheduled for
22 April 6, 2022. *Id.*; see also Mot. at Exs. 2 & 3.

23 Pursuant to NGC Regulations 2.020(1), 7.050, 7.070(5) and 7.130, the Commission
24 Chair is delegated the authority to issue rulings on discovery issues and other procedural
25 or prehearing matters that are not dispositive of the case. Specifically, NGC Regulation
26 7.070(5) authorizes the Chair to enter an order at any time on any matter delegated to the
27 Chair. Given the parties have stipulated to the completion of discovery by April 30, 2022,
28 the date scheduled for the deposition is imminent, and the timeframe to comply with the


1 Subpoena Duces Tecum is past due, a stay of Stadium Technology's response is appropriate
2 pending the resolution of the Motion and related discovery disputes. Further, a meet and
3 confer is necessary to allow for all parties involved (Stadium Technology included) to
4 address the procedural and discovery matters concerning the subpoenas.

5 **THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Stadium Technology's compliance
6 with, and response to the Subpoena Duces Tecum is stayed.

7 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT** counsel for the parties and counsel for non-
8 party Stadium Technology appear and participate in a meeting with the Chair via video
9 conference at **2:30 p.m. on Monday, April 4, 2022**. A link to participate in the video
10 conference will be provided by the Executive Secretary.
