STIPULATION FOR SETTLEMENT AND ORDER

The State of Nevada, on relation of its NEVADA GAMING CONTROL BOARD (BOARD), Complainant herein, filed and served a Complaint, NGC Case No. 23-07, against the above-captioned RESPONDENT alleging certain violations of the Nevada Gaming Control Act and Regulations of the Nevada Gaming Commission.

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED to by the BOARD and RESPONDENT that the Complaint, NGC Case No. 23-07, filed against RESPONDENT in the above-entitled case shall be settled on the following terms and conditions:

- RESPONDENT admits each and every allegation set forth in the Complaint,
 NGC Case No. 23-07.
- 2. RESPONDENT fully understands and voluntarily waives the right to a public hearing on the charges and allegations set forth in the Complaint, the right to present and cross-examine witnesses, the right to a written decision on the merits of the Complaint, which must contain findings of fact and a determination of the issues presented, and the right to obtain judicial review of the Nevada Gaming Commission's decision.
- 3. RESPONDENT voluntarily surrendered its restricted gaming license on or about February 7, 2024. The BOARD placed an administrative hold on the surrender to

allow the BOARD to resolve the disciplinary matters pending against the RESPONDENT. RESPONDENT agrees that its restricted gaming license shall be revoked upon approval of this Stipulation for Settlement. However, this revocation shall not extend to the sole officer, director, and shareholder of RESPONDENT, Robert Douglas Kingston. The effect of RESPONDENT's surrender of its restricted gaming license on Robert Douglas Kingston shall be the surrender of his licenses to be the sole officer, director, and shareholder of RESPONDENT. Robert Douglas Kingston shall not be considered to have had his licenses revoked by the Nevada Gaming Commission for purposes of NRS 463.174.

- 4. RESPONDENT and its sole officer, director, and shareholder, Robert Douglas Kingston, additionally agree to the following settlement conditions:
- a. RESPONDENT and Robert Douglas Kingston shall not file an application for a license, finding of suitability, or registration for a period of five years from the date this Stipulation for Settlement is approved by the Nevada Gaming Commission.
- b. Robert Douglas Kingston shall re-take and demonstrate successful completion of a regulatory compliance seminar for restricted licensees which is deemed acceptable to the Board Chair or the Chair's designee within 6 months of the date this Stipulation for Settlement is approved by the Nevada Gaming Commission. This condition may be administratively extended by the Board Chair or the Chair's designee; and
- c. Robert Douglas Kingston shall retain gaming counsel or a person enrolled in accordance with Nevada Gaming Commission Regulation 10 for any future transaction involving the transfer of an interest of an entity licensed or registered under the Gaming Control Act of which he is, or proposes to become, a sole or part owner; for any future applications; and for any appearances before the BOARD or Nevada Gaming Commission subsequent to the hearing at which the Nevada Gaming Commission considers this Stipulation for Settlement.
- 5. RESPONDENT and Robert Douglas Kingston agree that they will fully cooperate with the BOARD in its investigation of Two Brothers Ventures, LLC.

- 6. In consideration for the execution of this Stipulation for Settlement, RESPONDENT, for itself, its heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby releases and forever discharges the State of Nevada, the Nevada Gaming Commission, the Nevada Gaming Control Board, the Nevada Attorney General and each of their members, agents, and employees in their individual and representative capacities, from any and all manner of actions, causes of action, suits, debts, judgments, executions, claims, and demands whatsoever known or unknown, in law and equity, that RESPONDENT ever had, now has, may have, or claims to have against any and all of the persons or entities named in this paragraph arising out of, or by reason of, the investigation of the allegations in the Complaint and this disciplinary action, NGC Case No. 23-07, or any other matter relating thereto.
- 7. In consideration for the execution of this Stipulation for Settlement, RESPONDENT hereby indemnifies and holds harmless the State of Nevada, the Nevada Gaming Commission, the Nevada Gaming Control Board, the Nevada Attorney General, and each of their members, agents, and employees in their individual and representative capacities against any and all claims, suits and actions, brought against the persons named in this paragraph by reason of the investigation of the allegations in the Complaint, filed in this disciplinary action, NGC Case No. 23-07, and all other matters relating thereto, and against any and all expenses, damages, charges and costs, including court costs and attorney fees, which may be sustained by the persons and entities named in this paragraph as a result of said claims, suits and actions.
- 8. RESPONDENT enters into this Stipulation for Settlement freely and voluntarily and acknowledges that RESPONDENT had an opportunity to consult with counsel prior to entering into this Stipulation for Settlement. RESPONDENT further acknowledges that this Stipulation for Settlement is not the product of force, threats, or any other form of coercion or duress, but is the product of discussions between RESPONDENT and the attorney for the BOARD.
 - 9. RESPONDENT and the BOARD acknowledge that this Stipulation for

Settlement is made to avoid litigation and economize resources. The parties agree and understand that this Stipulation for Settlement is intended to operate as full and final settlement of the Complaint filed against RESPONDENT in the above-entitled disciplinary case, NGC Case No. 23-07.

- 10. RESPONDENT and the BOARD recognize and agree that the Nevada Gaming Commission has the sole and absolute discretion to determine whether to accept this Stipulation for Settlement. RESPONDENT and the BOARD hereby waive any right they may have to challenge the impartiality of the Nevada Gaming Commission to hear the above-entitled case on the matters embraced in the Complaint if the Nevada Gaming Commission determines not to accept this Stipulation for Settlement. If the Nevada Gaming Commission does not accept the Stipulation for Settlement, it shall be withdrawn as null and void and Respondent's admissions, if any, that certain violations of the Nevada Gaming Control Act and the Regulations of the Nevada Gaming Commission occurred shall be withdrawn.
- 11. RESPONDENT and the BOARD agree and understand that this Stipulation for Settlement is intended to operate as the full and final settlement of the Complaint filed in NGC Case No. 23-07. The parties further agree and understand that any oral representations are superseded by this Stipulation for Settlement and that only those terms memorialized in writing herein shall be effective.
- 12. RESPONDENT agrees and understands that although this Stipulation for Settlement, if approved by the Nevada Gaming Commission, will settle the Complaint filed in NGC Case No. 23-07, that the allegations contained in the Complaint filed in NGC Case No. 23-07, and the terms of this Stipulation for Settlement, may be considered by the BOARD and/or the Nevada Gaming Commission, with regards to any and all applications by RESPONDENT that are currently pending before the BOARD or the Nevada Gaming Commission, or that are filed in the future with the BOARD.
- 13. RESPONDENT and the BOARD shall each bear their own costs incurred in this disciplinary action, NGC Case No. 23-07.
