

## Golden Point and Golden Point Supreme Game Rules

### DEALING AND GAMEPLAY

Golden Point and Golden Point Supreme are optional side wagers eligible to be placed on a game of Baccarat using 8 standard 52-card decks for either traditional or commission free versions. At the beginning of the game, the player may place any of the traditional wagers on a Baccarat game. Additionally, they may place a wager on Golden Point on either the Banker side, Player side, or both.

The game is then dealt and played as in normal Baccarat, with the Player and Banker hands being initially dealt 2 cards, potentially receiving a third card according to standard Baccarat dealing rules. Once the hands are final, all wagers are resolved.

### GOLDEN POINT

The Golden Point wager may be placed on either the Player or the Banker hand. If the wagered hand wins by 1 Point, the wager wins and is paid according to the configured pay table, as provided below. If the wagered hand loses, ties, or wins by more than 1 Point, the Golden Point wager will lose. The payouts are based on how many cards were dealt when the wagered hand wins by 1 Point.

The Golden Point Payouts table is listed below:

### GOLDEN POINT SUPREME

The Golden Point Supreme wager may be wagered prior to the beginning of a round of Baccarat. If the winning hand wins by 1 Point, there are a total of six cards dealt, and the final score is 9 over 8, 8 over 7, 7 over 6, 6 over 5, or 5 over 4, the wager wins and is paid according to configured pay table as provided below. In all other cases, the wager loses.
