



## With 3Up Bonus

### Rules and Procedures

#### **Game Description**

*Jackpot Hold'Em with 3Up Bonus* expands on *Jackpot Hold'Em* by introducing an optional side wager, 3Up Bonus, and is still played with a standard 52-card deck. The player begins by placing an Ante wager and an Xtra Bonus wager, in equal amounts. Optionally, the player may also place a Player Bonus wager and a 3 UP Bonus wager. Each player, and the dealer, is then dealt two cards face-down. Five cards are dealt facedown as community cards. The dealer turns the first community card face-up. The player then has the option to place a Play wager of value 3 times (3X) the Ante, or else check. Two additional community cards are revealed. If the player has not yet placed a Play wager, they may place a Play wager of value twice (2X) the Ante, or else check. The final two community cards are revealed. If the player has still not placed a Play wager, they must now place a Play wager of value equal to (1X) the Ante, or else fold and forfeit their Ante and Xtra Bonus wagers. *Note that the Player Bonus wager remains active regardless of whether the player places a Play wager or folds.* All cards are revealed, and all wagers are then resolved.

#### **3Up Bonus Wager**

The 3 UP Bonus wager is based on the 3-card Poker hand formed from the player's two cards and the first revealed community card. If the hand is a Pair or better, the wager wins and pays according to hand and according to configured payable, as given in the following table. Otherwise, the wager loses.
