

Lucy 5 Rules of Play

INTRODUCTION

Lucky 5 is a collection of five Baccarat side wagers that can be placed before any round of Baccarat played with a shoe containing between 3 and 8 standard 52-card decks. If the house chooses to offer the All 4 wager, it must also offer the Bank 7, Swan 8, Rabbit 9, and Matching 7s wagers. A Player and Banker hand are then dealt according to standard Baccarat rules, with each hand potentially receiving a third card based on the traditional drawing rules. Once the hands are complete, all side wagers are resolved.

RULES OF PLAY

WAGERS

Bank 7 Wager

Wins and pays 40 to 1 if the Banker hand totals 7 with three cards and is greater than the Player hand. Otherwise, the wager loses.

Swan 8 Wager

Wins and pays 25 to 1 if the Player hand totals 8 with three cards and is greater than the Banker hand. Otherwise, the wager loses.

Rabbit 9 Wager

Wins if either hand totals 9 with three cards, with payouts determined by the specific scenario outlined in the corresponding payout table. Otherwise, the wager loses.

Matching 7s Wager

Wins if both the Player and Banker hands total 7 and have the same number of cards, with payouts based on the applicable scenario in the payout table. Otherwise, the wager loses.

All 4 Wager

Wins and pays 6 to 1 if any of the following wagers win: Bank 7, Swan 8, Rabbit 9, or Matching 7s. If none of these wagers win, the All 4 wager loses.

Bank 7 Paytable

Scenario	Pay
Banker Three-Card 7 Greater Than Player	40 to 1

Swan 8 Paytable

Scenario	Pay
Player Three-Card 8 Greater Than Banker	25 to 1

Rabbit 9 Paytable

Scenario	Pay
Both Hands Have Three-Card 9	75 to 1
One Hand Has Three-Card 9	10 to 1

Matching 7s Paytable

Scenario	Pay
Both Hands Have Three-Card 7	200 to 1
Both Hands Have Two-Card 7	50 to 1

All 4 Paytable

Scenario	Pay
If Win For Bank 7, Swan 8, Rabbit 9 or Matching 7s	6 to 1
