The Technology Division has reviewed your application requesting approval of On/Off Advantaged Play. On/Off Advantaged Play is a new game, which is played using Accumulation Station LLC's proprietary 50-card On/Off Advantaged Play deck, consisting of 10 "½-Pot" cards and 40 "Build" cards.

The theoretical payback percentage of On/Off Advantaged Play is 95.00%.

In accordance with Nevada Gaming Commission Regulation 14.230, approval of On/Off Advantaged Play is granted. This letter does not constitute an approval of any associated equipment or any other hardware and software necessary for the conduct of the game.
