## GAME RULES - Pai Gow Poker Progressive Cash Spin

## **Game Description**

Pai Gow Poker Progressive Cash Spin is an optional fixed amount progressive wager that may be configured with Pai Gow Poker-style games using a 53-card deck with the 52 standard cards and 1 Joker. Eligible games include, but are not limited to, Fortune Pai Gow and Face Up Pai Gow. The player may place the Progressive wager during the normal wagering period. The game is then dealt and played as normal. The progressive wager is based on the player's 7 cards. If a Joker is present in the player's hand, it may only be used as an Ace, or to complete a Royal Flush or Straight Flush.

## **Dealing Procedures**

If the player's hand contains a Full House or better, the wager wins and pays according to the paytable. Otherwise, the wager loses. Note, the progressive awards are independent of how the player chooses to set their hand. Certain awards will trigger a spin of a Cash Spin wheel, with the player receiving an award based on the outcome of the spin. Note that the player's original wager is not returned regardless of whether the player wins an award.

## **Envy Prize Option**

Pai Gow Poker Progressive Cash Spin also has a paytable option for an envy prize. Awards that trigger a spin of a Cash Spin wheel will also award an Envy prize to all other players at the table that participated in the progressive wager. These Envy prizes may be configured as fixed pays, or as pays from a separate progressive meter. For the fixed pay configuration, the listed pays are paid to each player except for the player that triggered the prize. For the progressive configuration, the listed percentage of the progressive meter is split between all players except for the player that triggered the prize. The listed fixed Envy pays are for a \$5 wager and must scale proportionally with the wager size. Note that the player's original wager is not returned regardless of whether the player wins an award.

The Cash Spin wheels may award the full contents of a progressive meter, a part of a meter, or a fixed prize. The fixed prizes are for a \$5 wager and must scale proportionally with the wager size. For each of the progressives, Ultra and FPG, a configured percentage of each wager is used to increment associated primary and reserve meters. In the event of a 100% Progressive award, the primary meter will be reseeded by the contents of the reserve meter.
