Game Description

Supreme Pai Gow is a commission-free, house-banked Pai Gow poker-based game using a standard 52-card deck and a Joker. The object of the game is for the players to beat the dealer with both their two-card low hand and their five-card high hand. Unlike standard Pai Gow, players have the option to play, by raising 1x to 4x their Ante wager, or fold. *Supreme Pai Gow* also contains optional bonus wagers that are not dependent on the base game's outcome.

Rules of Play

1. To begin each round, each player must place an *Ante* wager and may place any of the available optional bonus and/or progressive wagers.
2. After all wagers are placed, each player is dealt four cards and the dealer is dealt eight cards. All cards being dealt face-down.
3. After examining their four cards, each player must decide to do one of the following:
 - a. **Play**, by placing a *Raise* wager equal to 1x to 4x their *Ante* wager
 - b. **Fold**, and lose their *Ante* wager
4. Each player that has placed a *Raise* wager will now receive their three remaining cards.
 - a. Players that have placed an optional bonus wager requiring a 7-card hand must be dealt their remaining three cards, regardless of whether they choose to raise or fold.
5. Each player must set a 2-card low hand and a 5-card high hand and place them in their designated spots on the layout. If the low hand is incorrectly set to be of greater value than the high hand, the hand is a foul and settled in accordance with house procedure.
6. Once all players have set their hands, the dealer will reveal their cards and set their 5-card high hand and 2-card low hand according to the House Way. Note that the remaining card, that is not part of the dealer's high and low hands, is used to evaluate the *Dealer's 8th Card* wager, if configured.
7. Each player's hands are compared to the dealer's respective hands and the *Ante* and *Raise* wagers are reconciled as follows:
 - a. If *both* the player's hands *beat* the dealer's respective hands, the *Ante* and *Raise* wagers win and are paid 1 to 1.
 - b. If *both* the player's hands *lose or tie* the dealer's respective hands, the *Ante* and *Raise* wagers lose.
 - c. If one of the player's hands *beats* the dealer's respective hand and the other hand *loses or ties* the dealer's respective hand, the *Ante* wager wins and is paid 1 to 1 and the *Raise* wager pushes.
8. Regardless of the outcome of the *Ante* and *Raise* wagers, each player that has made a *Raise* wager is eligible to receive an *Ante Royalty* pay, based on their 7-card hand.
9. The dealer reconciles all optional bonus wagers.

Optional Bonus Wagers

Operators choose which optional bonus wager(s) they will offer and set all minimum and maximum wagering limits.

Pai Gow Insurance

Players win if their 7-card hand is a Pai Gow and are paid based on the corresponding payable(s) in Appendix B.

Emperor's Treasure (with Envy Bonus)

Players win if their 7-card hand achieves a winning event based on the corresponding payable(s) in Appendix C.

Envy Bonus

If the player's *Emperor's Treasure* wager is \$5 or more, a designated lammer is placed directly adjacent to their *Emperor's Treasure* wager, indicating that the player is eligible to receive an *Envy Bonus* pay if another player at the table achieves a Four-of-a-Kind or better, based on the corresponding *Envy Bonus* payable(s) in Appendix B. Players cannot win an *Envy Bonus* on their own hand.

7-Card Bonus

Players win if their 7-card hand achieves a winning event based on the corresponding payable(s) in Appendix D.

Dealer's 8th Card

Three separate optional wagers, based on the value of the dealer's unused 8th card, that are paid according to the corresponding payable(s) in Appendix E.

Pai Gow Insurance Progressive

Players win if their 7-card hand is a Queen High Pai Gow or less and is paid based on the corresponding payable(s) in Appendix F.

Emperor's Treasure Progressive

Players win if their 7-card hand achieves a winning event based on the corresponding payable(s) in Appendix G.

2. All players who have made a *Raise* wager are eligible to receive an *Ante Royalty* pay based on their qualifying hand, regardless of the *Ante* and *Raise* outcomes and in addition to any applicable *Ante* and *Raise* pays.
3. Only the highest qualifying hand is paid.
4. Operators may choose to post a maximum aggregate per hand or per round.
