Re: Joint Comments to Proposed Amendments to NGC Regulation 5.160 and
Surveillance Standards ("Proposed Surveillance Amendments")

Dear Executive Secretary Rupert:

On behalf of Ole Nugget Corporation dba Fallon Nugget and Fernley Nugget Casino Corporation dba Fernley Nugget, we respectfully submit the comment listed below:

Surveillance Standard 2.010 #9

The proposed amendment to Surveillance Standard 2.010 #9 states category "B" licensees must have at least one person on the property at all times trained in the use of the equipment, with knowledge of the games and house rules.

The Fallon Nugget operates one poker table, two nights a week. The Fernley Nugget operates one poker table approximately once a month. The proposed standards require these locations to always have someone on property that is trained to operate the surveillance system and be knowledgeable of the poker rules and procedures. This requirement requires extra staff even for the time when the non-restricted licensee is operating slot machines only.

To meet the spirit of the proposed regulation, we suggest Surveillance Standard 2.010 #9 states:

For all category "B" licensees, there must be at least one person on the property at all times trained in the use of the equipment, with knowledge of the games and house rules when the table or card games are in operation.
