PURPOSE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS

2026-10R: PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO NGC REGULATION 14 – MANUFACTURERS, DISTRIBUTORS, OPERATORS OF INTER-CASINO LINKED SYSTEMS, GAMING DEVICES, NEW GAMES, INTER-CASINO LINKED SYSTEMS, ON-LINE SLOT METERING SYSTEMS, CASHLESS WAGERING SYSTEMS, MOBILE GAMING SYSTEMS, INTERACTIVE GAMING SYSTEMS AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT; INDEPENDENT TESTING LABORATORIES: SECTIONS 14.045 (MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR INTER-CASINO LINKED SYSTEMS)

PURPOSE: In accordance with NRS 463.145, 463.150, and 463.15993 to amend Regulation 14.045 to revise the minimum rate of progression relating to inter-casino linked systems featuring a progressive payoff schedule that increases as the inter-casino linked system is played; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.
