**SUBJECT: Submission Requirements for Written Surveillance System Plans for
Restricted Licensees (NGC Regulation 5.160)**

Pursuant to the recent amendments to Nevada Gaming Commission (NGC) Regulation 5.160, the Nevada Gaming Control Board (Board) is providing guidance to **restricted licensees** regarding the submission of written surveillance system plans.

Under NGC Regulation 5.160(9), licensees are required to submit a written surveillance system plan to the Chair. This plan must include a diagram identifying all areas to be monitored and the specific placement of surveillance equipment.

To streamline this process and ensure compliance for restricted licensees, the Board clarifies the following:

- This requirement may be satisfied by incorporating camera placements directly onto the floor diagram submitted to the Board pursuant to NGC Regulation 4.090.
- Restricted licensees who have already submitted a floor diagram under Regulation 4.090 may meet the new requirement by submitting a revised diagram that includes the necessary camera information.

- A floor diagram that accurately reflects camera placements and coverage will be deemed to satisfy the surveillance plan requirement for restricted locations under subsection 9.

Licensees are reminded that any subsequent modifications to the surveillance system that result in a change to the approved plan must be updated and maintained on the licensed premises.

Revised diagrams should also be submitted to Board's Tax and License Division at **taxandlicense@gcb.nv.gov**. Please ensure all submissions are clearly labeled with the establishment name and license number.

This notice is issued to provide guidance on the implementation of Regulation 5.160 and does not supersede the formal text of the Nevada Gaming Regulations.
