At its meeting on August 20, 2026, the Nevada Gaming Commission (NGC) adopted amendments to certain provisions of the NGC Regulations. Below are the amended sections along with their effective dates. The adopted amendments have been codified into the corresponding chapters of the NGC Regulations.
