SUBJECT: Update to Process of Industry Regulation 3.010(1)

As of October 15, 2025, with respect to Regulation 3.010(1), and the Board's expectations regarding the process of obtaining information from churches, schools, and children's public playgrounds is that the applicant demonstrate a good faith effort in contacting them. Effective immediately, applicants for restricted gaming licenses are required to reach out to churches, schools, and children's public playgrounds, within the 1,500 feet of the proposed restricted gaming location to request their feedback on the operation of gaming near their location. The feedback shall be provided to the Board upon request. The Board recommends that the applicant implement this process no later than at the time the application is filed with the Board, as these locations are to be identified and noted with the application, as listed in the Restricted License Instructions posted on the Board's website. If there is any question about whether an organization within the applicable vicinity is to be considered a church, school or children's public playground, please contact the Board for further direction.
