SUBJECT: Gaming License Printout Available Through GCB Apps Online Portal

Effective December 29, 2025, the Nevada Gaming Control Board's ("Board") Tax and License Division will no longer mail gaming licenses. Licensees will have the ability to print gaming licenses through the GCB Apps online portal upon payment of all state license fees, taxes, and bond, if applicable, as required by law and regulation of the Nevada Gaming Commission pursuant to NRS 463.225 and NRS 463.270.

The Location Administrator and authorized subordinate users who are granted license printing access will have the ability to access the "Print License" tab, select the licensed gaming establishment(s), and print the license(s). Authorized users will also have the ability to print a replacement or an amended license from the portal. Amended licenses will require approval from Tax and License prior to printing.

Traditionally, gaming licenses were printed on blue paper; however, this is no longer a requirement. Licenses can be printed on any type of paper at the discretion and sound judgment of the licensee and must be posted at all times in a conspicuous place in the area where gaming is conducted pursuant to NRS 463.260.
