**SUBJECT:** **Table Games and Slots Minimum Internal Control Standards (V9) for Gaming Salons and the Monthly Gross Revenue Statistical Report Gaming Salon (NGC-30)**

As of June 1, 2023, all Group I licensees were required to comply with Version 9 of the Minimum Internal Control Standards ("MICS").

The Nevada Gaming Control Board ("Board") is granting a variation that removes the requirement for Group I licensees to comply with Table Games MICS (V9) #139 - #142 and Slots MICS (V9) #113, which relate to gaming salons. This variation is effective immediately. Group I licensees must update their written systems of internal control to reflect this change no later than June 1, 2026.

Additionally, Group I licensees are no longer required to file the Monthly Gross Revenue Statistical Report Gaming Salon (NGC-30) for periods after February 2026.
