1. 2026-07R—NGC REGULATION 30 – HORSE RACING

DISCUSSION, AND POSSIBLE RECOMMENDATION TO THE NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION, OF AMENDMENTS TO NGC REGULATION 30 REGARDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, DEFINITIONS; HORSE RACING DECISIONS; REPORTING AND RECORDKEEPING; EXTENDED STEWARDS' JURISDICTION; HORSE IDENTIFICATION (INCLUDING MICROCHIPS); RACE-DATES APPLICATION DEADLINE AND RACE OFFICIAL/JOCKEY REQUIREMENTS; INCORPORATION AND MODIFICATION OF CURRENT ARCI MODEL RULES FOR PAYOUTS AND POOL DISTRIBUTIONS; LICENSE DURATION; SAFETY AND WHIP REQUIREMENTS; WAGERING INTEREST MINIMUMS; AND REVISIONS TO THE DISCIPLINARY, HEARING, AND APPEALS PROCESSES; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO.

PURPOSE: To clarify and update NGC Regulation 30, as a whole; to remove gender specific pronouns; to define terms used in NGC Regulation 30, including, without limitation, "ARCI," "Bar," "Discipline," "Racing official," "Ringer," and "Steward;" to clarify that the Board Chair and designees, state steward, and stewards make decisions with regard to NGC Regulation 30; to update reporting and recording requirements; to extend the jurisdictional time period of the stewards; to include microchips in horse identification requirements; to set a date by which an application for race dates must be filed; to require the names of race officials with an application for award of race dates; to update jockey reporting times; to specify the most current version of the ARCI model rules regarding payouts and distributions of pools applies; to specify how the Chair may modify ARCI rules regarding payouts and distributions; to revise the duration of licenses; to create a safety section in NGC Regulation 30; to revise whip requirements; to cross reference the most current version of the ARCI Model Rules; to update the minimum betting interests required for certain wagers; to revise and update the disciplinary process; to revise and update the hearing process; to revise and update the appeals process; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.

2. 2026-08R—NGC REGULATION 21 – LIVE BROADCASTS

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE RECOMMENDATION TO THE NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION OF AMENDMENTS TO NGC REGULATION 21.020 REGARDING LIVE BROADCASTS, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, REMOVAL OF AN OUTDATED CROSS-REFERENCE; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO.

PURPOSE: To amend NGC Regulation 21.020 pursuant to NRS 463.440 to remove an outdated and unnecessary cross-reference and to make conforming revisions as necessary to clarify the existing regulatory language governing Board authorization of agreements for the use of live broadcasts, and to take such additional actions as may be necessary and proper to effectuate this stated purpose.
