SUBJECT: **Distributions of Gaming Devices Out of Nevada**

The Nevada Gaming Commission (“Commission”) approved revisions to Regulation 14.180(2), during its February 26, 2026 meeting, amending the reporting requirements for licensed distributors. Effective immediately, the Nevada Gaming Control Board (“Board”) will require the submission of an electronic record of all current customers for out of state shipment of gaming devices, on January 15th of each year. The category I and II classifications, and semi-annual submissions will no longer apply and the “ENF-126” form will no longer be used. All information required by Regulation 14.180(1) must be available to Board agents and maintained for five years.

Additionally, all other gaming device distributions, related to Regulation 14.190 and 14.330, will now also be under the purview of the Tax and License Division. Inquiries and requests should be sent to the email address noted above.
