The Nevada Gaming Control Board (Board) will hold a regulation workshop to discuss, receive public input, and take possible action to recommend to the Nevada Gaming Commission (NGC or Commission) amendments to NGC Regulations 15C and 16 as part of its regular monthly meeting scheduled for **9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, April 8, 2026**, and continue on **Thursday, April 9, 2026**, at the following locations:

### **PURPOSE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS**

**2026-09R: PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO NGC REGULATION 15C – PRIVATE INVESTMENT COMPANIES: SECTIONS 15C.100 (REQUIRED REPORTS), AND 15C.200 (APPROVALS REQUIRED)**

**PURPOSE:** In accordance with NRS 463.145, 463.150, to amend NGC Regulation 15C.100 to require a registered private investment company to report any new issuances of any type of class of economic securities and all recipients of such securities and to amend deadlines for reporting requirements; to amend NGC Regulation 15C.200 to require prior Commission approval before declaring, in addition to dividends or distributions, any redemptions, or any other form of payment, on any class of securities to any person who has not been licensed or found suitable by the Commission; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.

**2026-09R: PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO NGC REGULATION 16 – PUBLICLY TRADED CORPORATIONS AND PUBLIC OFFERINGS OF SECURITIES: SECTION 16.115 (CONTINUOUS OR DELAYED PUBLIC OFFERINGS)**

**PURPOSE:** In accordance with NRS 463.145, NRS 463.150, and NRS 463.635, to amend NGC Regulation 16.115 to clarify that an affiliated company which is a registered publicly traded corporation may apply for approval of a continuous or delayed public offering if such affiliated company has a class of securities listed, as a foreign issuer or foreign private issuer, on the applicable foreign country's securities exchange or over-the-counter market; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.
