CONSIDERATION OF ADOPTION OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO NGC REGULATION 14.045 REGARDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, A REDUCTION IN THE MINIMUM RATE OF PROGRESSION FOR THE PRIMARY JACKPOT METER OF AN INTER-CASINO LINKED SYSTEM FEATURING A PROGRESSIVE PAYOFF SCHEDULE THAT INCREASES AS THE INTER-CASINO LINKED SYSTEM IS PLAYED FROM .4 OF ONE PERCENT OF AMOUNTS WAGERED TO .1 OF ONE PERCENT OF AMOUNTS WAGERED, AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO.

PURPOSE: In accordance with NRS 463.145, 463.150, and 463.15993, to amend Regulation 14.045 to revise the minimum rate of progression relating to inter-casino linked systems featuring a progressive payoff schedule that increases as the inter-casino linked system is played; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.
