SUBJECT: Nevada Gaming Commission Acceptance of Nominations for Appointment to the Off-Track Pari-Mutuel Wagering Committee

This notice is to advise that the Nevada Gaming Commission (Commission) is accepting nominations for the appointment of one successor member to the Off-Track Pari-Mutuel Wagering Committee (Committee) pursuant to *Nevada Revised Statutes* (NRS) [464.020\(5\)](#). The position to be filled is governed by NRS 464.020(5)(b). Any person appointed to the position must be licensed to engage in off-track pari-mutuel wagering and satisfy the criteria set forth in NRS 464.020(5)(b).

NRS 464.020(5) provides, in pertinent part:

5. The Nevada Gaming Commission may appoint an Off-Track Pari-Mutuel Wagering Committee consisting of 11 persons who are licensed to engage in off-track pari-mutuel wagering. If the Commission appoints such a Committee, it shall appoint to the Committee:

...

(b) Three members who, in the preceding year, paid gross revenue fees pursuant to NRS 463.370 in an amount that was less than the average amount of gross revenue fees paid by licensees engaged in off-track pari-mutuel wagering in the preceding year; and

...

➤ If a vacancy occurs in a position on the committee for any reason, including, but not limited to, termination of a member, the commission shall appoint a successor member who satisfies the same criteria in paragraph (a), (b) or (c) that applied to the member whose position has been vacated.

To assist interested parties in determining whether they satisfy the criterion set forth in NRS 464.020(5)(b), the average amount of gross revenue fees paid pursuant to NRS 463.370 by licensees engaged in off-track pari-mutuel wagering during the preceding year was **\$9,114,096**. This amount is based on the annual gross revenue fees paid by such licensees for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2026.

Accordingly, a nominee for this position must be licensed to engage in off-track pari-mutuel wagering and must have paid gross revenue fees pursuant to NRS 463.370 during the preceding year in an amount below **\$9,114,096**.

Any successor appointed to this position will serve for the remainder of the current Committee term. Pursuant to the Commission's November 16, 2023, Order, unless terminated earlier, the appointment of the Committee and its authority will expire at midnight of the November 2028 Commission meeting on the date the matter is considered.
