SUBJECT: Change to Internal Revenue Service Threshold for Reporting Gambling

Winnings

The Internal Revenue Service ("IRS") has released an early draft of the W-2G tax form and instructions for which, in addition to other thresholds, adjust the threshold amount for reporting gambling winnings based on yearly inflation amounts. The minimum reporting threshold amount for gambling winnings will change for calendar year-end 2026. Draft forms and instructions, as well as the current tax forms authorized for use, are available on the IRS website.

Please note that the draft forms released by the IRS are provided for your information only and should not be used. It will be the licensee's responsibility to monitor for the release of the official forms and instructions.

This change will not affect any compliance requirements set forth by the Minimum Internal Control Standards (MICS) for Group I licensees and the Internal Control Procedures (ICPs) for Group II licensees.
