### Nevada Gaming Regulators Complete Modernization Initiative

The Nevada Gaming Control Board (“Board”) announced today the completion of a regulatory modernization initiative which started in July 2025 and encompassed 43 regulation projects, representing one of the Board’s most comprehensive regulatory initiatives undertaken in recent years.

This initiative was designed to modernize Nevada’s regulatory efforts to keep pace with an evolving gaming industry and addressed the following key areas:

- **Technology Modernization:** Updates to regulations governing cloud computing, wagering account functionality, cybersecurity reporting, gaming device approvals, associated equipment, hosting center operations, and technical standards.
- **Anti-Money Laundering:** Updates to reporting requirements, compliance obligations, and regulatory provisions designed to support effective risk management and regulatory oversight.
- **Overhaul of Regulation 30:** Updates to governing horse racing operations in Nevada included addressing operational requirements, disciplinary procedures, licensing and integrity related provisions, and longstanding regulatory clarifications.
- **Enforcement and Investigative Processes:** Updates to regulations governing surveillance, exclusion related provisions, gaming operations, and other regulatory tools that support the Board’s ability to effectively monitor and oversee licensed gaming activities.
- **Gaming Operations:** A broad range of operational areas were addressed, including gaming salons, wagering related activities, house rules, chips and tokens, disseminators, and other operational requirements affecting day-to-day gaming activities.

“These efforts reflect our commitment to maintaining a regulatory framework that is responsive to innovation, effective in its oversight responsibilities, and capable of supporting the continued success of Nevada’s gaming industry,” stated Chairman Mike Dreitzer.

"Nevada has built a reputation as the nation's leader in gaming regulation, and our regulatory framework must continue to evolve alongside the industry," said Governor Joe Lombardo. "This work reflects our broader commitment to making state government more responsive, effective, and adaptable to Nevadans' needs."
