New Game vs Variation

A **New Game** is a game that is materially different from any other table game previously approved in Nevada. This may include completely new game themes, new types of wheels or other gaming equipment that has not been used in this manner before, or changing major aspects of the game such as going from a peer-to-peer/rake version to a house-banked version.

A **Variation** is typically a game where the core game is already approved and what is submitted is the addition of a side bet, a new paytable for either the base game or side bet, the introduction of new betting options, the use of additional equipment to conduct the game, or a difference in dealing procedure.
