SUBJECT:

Preliminary Technical Compliance Reviews

To facilitate the efficient entry of gaming products into Nevada and to enhance the communication between the Innovator, the Gaming Control Board, and the Independent Test Lab (ITL), applicants for a manufacturer's license may begin the conceptual and technical review of their product(s) with the Board for compliance prior to the applicant receiving a manufacturer's license.

In order to begin the process, the applicant must have a complete application on file with the Board's Investigations Division and have fully funded their investigative account in accordance with NGC Regulation 4.070. A separate account with the Technology Division may be required to fund the product compliance review.

The process should flow as follows:

- 1. Complete application for licensure as a manufacturer and fund investigative account.
- Consultation between the Applicant and the GCB
 Technology Division staff will work directly with the applicant to review the use and implementation of their product to address potential regulatory compliance concerns prior to significant product development, ITL certification, or submission to the Board for approval.

- 3. Pre-approval Certification by an ITL
 All gaming devices and gaming associated equipment must be submitted to an ITL for
 testing and certification prior to submission to the GCB for final approval.
- 4. Submission to the GCB for final approval Final product approval cannot be granted until the applicant has received a manufacturer's license.
