- 2. THAT Bally Manufacturing Corporation be, and it hereby is, granted approval to continue to be a nonrestricted slot operator, and a manufacturer and distributor of gaming

devices in the State of Nevada through its affiliated company, Bally Distributing Company, subject to the reporting requirements, except the standardized credit accounting procedures set forth in paragraph 4 on pages 4 and 5, as outlined in Exhibit "A" which is attached to this Order and incorporated by reference herein, while participating in gaming activities in Atlantic City, New Jersey.

3. THAT except as otherwise expressly modified by this Order of Registration, or other Commission action, all other terms and conditions of the Order of Registration dated February 22, 1979 are reaffirmed.
