- 1. THAT the application of Circus Circus Enterprises, Inc., as amended and supplemented, for approval of a continuous or delayed public offering pursuant to Regulation 16.115, is hereby accepted as filed.
- 2. THAT Circus Circus Enterprises, Inc. is hereby given approval to make public offerings for a period of one year, subject to the following conditions:
- a. That at all times during the year, Circus Circus Enterprises, Inc. shall timely file all reports required by Section 13 or Section 15(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934;

- b. That Circus Circus Enterprises, Inc. shall notify the State

 Gaming Control Board, Investigation Division, Corporate Securities, prior to the
 sale of any securities for which Commission approval would otherwise be required;
 and
- c. That the approval herein granted may be rescinded without notice upon the issuance of an interlocutory stop order by the Chairman of the State Gaming Control Board. Said interlocutory stop order, if issued, shall remain in effect until the interlocutory stop order is lifted by the Commission upon such terms as are satisfactory to the Commission.
- 3. THE COMMISSION hereby delegates to the Chairman of the State Gaming Control Board the authority to issue interlocutory stop orders for good cause; which shall remain in effect until lifted by the Commission as provided in 2(c) above.
