Rules of Play

211 Poker is a variation to the standard game of Poker (Omaha Hi-Lo). The game is played using a standard deck of 52 cards where the player is the banker. 211 Poker is a "High – Low" split game consisting of four betting rounds. However, the game may be played as 'high only' or 'low only.'

Each player, beginning with the person to the immediate left of the dealer button, receives one card at a time until four cards have been dealt to each player. The first round betting occurs, wherein the players have the traditional choices of folding, checking, betting and raising. The dealer then exposes a two card 'flop,' which is used by all players to make up their hand. The game continues in the traditional way of dealing with a round of betting between the dealing of the 'turn' and 'river' cards.

The player may then use two or three cards from their original hand, or two or three cards from the community cards to make up their five card poker hand.

211 Poker offers a unique feature to the game known as the '7 low condition.' This means that a player's hand must have no cards higher than a seven, with no pairs, or three or four-of-a-kinds in order to qualify for a low winning hand. Straights and flushes falling within these parameters may also qualify for the low hand winner.
