6 Card Bonus for Various Poker Variation Games

There are seven different possible game titles that have the 6 Card Bonus side bet. All pays are based on a 5 card poker hand (or a 6 card poker hand for higher payouts). The various poker game variations follow the standard Rules of Play for each game with the addition of this optional side bet. 6 Card Bonus is an optional side bet that utilizes a combination of the player's cards and the 6 Card Bonus card(s) to make the best five-card poker hand, but in addition there are higher pays based on all six cards. There are certain wagers on each base game that must be played in order to also play the 6 Card Bonus bet.

The games that can utilize a 6 Card Bonus paytable are:

- Crazy 4 Poker
- Four Card Poker
- Let It Ride
- Mississippi Stud
- Texas Hold'em Bonus
- Ultimate Texas Hold'em
- Three Card Poker

The combination of cards to make the 6 Card Bonus hand are as following:

- > Crazy 4 Poker The 6 Card Bonus side bet combines the player's five cards with the one card from the 6 Card Bonus card box to make the best five card poker hand.
- Four Card Poker The 6 Card Bonus side bet combines the player's five cards with the one card from the 6 Card Bonus Card box.
- Let it Ride Bonus Players combine their three cards with the three additional cards dealt and placed in the 6 Card Bonus card box.
- Mississippi Stud After all bets are made, the dealer will place four cards in the 6 Card Bonus card box. These are combined with the two cards dealt to the player.
- Texas Hold'Em Bonus Players combine their two hole cards with the four 6 Card Bonus cards
- > Ultimate Texas Hold'Em Players combine their two hole cards with the four cards in the 6 Card Bonus card box.
- Three Card Poker Players combine their three-card hand with the dealer's three-card hand.

RULES OF PLAY:

- 1. The dealer then follows house procedures for dealing the regular game.
- 2. The dealer reconciles the standard wager, any side bet wagers and progressive pays based on the procedures for the regular game. All hands are resolved at the same time.
- 3. Once all base game and side bets have been resolved, the dealer will discard the community cards.
- 4. The dealer will then reveal the cards in the 6 Card Bonus card box and working from right to left the dealer will combine them with the players starting cards making the best 5 card poker hand. The only exception is the top 4 hands which are based on all 6 cards. See paytable for odds.
