All in Stud

All in Stud is played using a standard 52-card deck of cards. To begin, players must make a mandatory Ante wager to receive three cards which are combined with two community cards as Raise wagers are placed. Players use five cards to achieve a poker hand that triggers a winning event against a paytable. Additionally, players may place any optional side wagers made available.

Five-Card Progressive is an optional side bet. Players are paid against a paytable if they are able to create a qualifying hand that uses the player's three cards and the two community cards to match a winning triggering event.

All 6 Bonus

The All 6 Bonus is an optional side bet. Players are paid against a paytable if they are able to create a qualifying hand that uses the player's three hole cards combined with the three All 6 community cards. Otherwise, the All 6 Bonus side bet is lost. The dealer will deal three All 6 cards prior to dealing the standard game or after and place them in the designated area of the layout.
