Bad Beat Pai Gow Poker Rules of Play

Bad Beat Pai Gow Poker is a variation to the standard game of Pai Gow Poker. The game is an optional side wager that wins if both of the player's hands lose to the dealer's hands. Bad Beat Pai Gow Poker pays odds based on the player's two-card hand.

| Losing 2-Card Hand | Payout |
|----------------------------|------------|
| Pair of Aces | 1,000 to 1 |
| Pair of Kings | 500 to 1 |
| Pair of Queens | 100 to ` |
| Pair of Jacks | 50 to 1 |
| Pair of Tens | 25 to 1 |
| Pair of 9, 8, 7, 6, or 5's | 15 to 1 |
| Pair of 4, 3, or 2's | 10 to 1 |
| Ace/King | 5 to 1 |
| Ace/Queen or less | 1 to 1 |

The Bad Beat Pai Gow Poker side wager may not exceed one-half of the regular Pai Gow Poker wager. Player-bankers can make a Bad Beat Pai Gow Poker side wager and it will be settled against the 'house' hand. Non-Player-banker Bad Beat Paigow Poker side wagers are settle against the banker hand.'
