Blazing Pairs

Rules of Play

Blazing Pairs is an optional side bet for Blackjack. The game is played using one, two, six or eight decks of standard 52 cards.

To begin, players must make a wager on the main Blackjack game and may also place an optional Blazing Pairs side bet.

The player's first two cards are used to form a two card poker hand that pays odds according to the posted paytable. (see samples below) If the player's two cards do not form a hand associated with a winning payout, the Blazing Pairs side bet is lost.

After the Blazing Pairs side bet has been resolved, the standard game of Blackjack continues.
