## BREAK THE HOUSE BLACKJACK RULES OF PLAY

- 1. "Break The House Blackjack" is an optional bonus wager for Blackjack games played with 2, 6 or 8 standard 52-card decks.
- 2. The "Break The House Blackjack" bonus wager is optional and has no effect on the underlying base game of Blackjack.
- 3. At the start of the hand, prior to the dealing of any cards, the player has an option to play "Break The House Blackjack" by placing their desired wager amount in the "Break The House Blackjack" bonus wager circle.
- 4. The "Break The House Blackjack" bonus wager pays odds based upon the dealer's completed blackjack hand breaking/busting by exceeding 21 points (only the dealer's hand applies to this wager), according to the tables listed below:

- If the dealer possesses a blackjack, all players' "Break The House Blackjack" bonus wagers lose.
- If the dealer's final hand does not exceed 21 points, all players' "Break The House Blackjack" bonus wagers lose.
- If a player is dealt a blackjack or busts (draws to a hand exceeding 21 points), that player's "Break The House Blackjack" bonus wager remains in action for that hand.
- In the event all players bust or have blackjack and there are active "Break The House Blackjack" wagers, the dealer will play out the hand to its conclusion (drawing cards as if players are still live in the hand) in order to resolve the "Break The House Blackjack" bonus wagers.
