Introduction

DiamondZ is an optional bonus wager that can be added to any existing poker game that uses a single deck of playing cards, with or without the joker. DiamondZ can be added to the following games:

Caribbean Stud
Crazy 4 Poker
DJ Wild Stud Poker
Four Card Poker
I Luv Suits Poker
Let it Ride
Mississippi Stud
Six Card Poker Two Way Bad Beat
Texas Hold'em Bonus
Three Card Poker
Ultimate Texas Hold'em
Pai Gow Poker
Face Up Pai Gow Poker
Fortune Pai Gow Poker

The bonus wager utilizes the cards dealt in sequence for the base game. The game may be configure to use 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, or 14 cards dealt to the player, the dealer and (if applicable) community cards.

The bonus wager awards payouts according to the number of diamond suited cards that are obtained between the player, the dealer and (if applicable) the community cards. (See sample paytable)
