## "FREE FLOP" HOLD'EM

## WHERE BETTING DOESN'T BEGIN UNTIL AFTER THE FLOP!!

- 1. Free Flop Hold'em is played exactly the same as Texas Hold'em, the only exception being that there is no pre-flop betting round.
- 2. There is a button that moves clockwise around the table as normal after every hand.
- 3. There is a small and big blind as normal.
- 4. Deal begins with the small blind first, and moves clockwise around the table with the player on the button receiving cards last.
- 5. Dealer deals out the flop (first 3 community cards). Action starts with the first player left of the big blind. He/she may call/raise/fold, and the action moves clockwise as normal. When action returns to the blind/s, they have an option to call, check, or raise.
- 6. Dealer deals out the turn card (4<sup>th</sup> community card). Action starts with the first player left of the button. He/she may check or bet, and the action moves clockwise as normal.
- 7. Dealer deals out the river card (5<sup>th</sup> community card). Action starts with the first player left of the button. He/she may check or bet, and the action moves clockwise as normal.
- 8. A bet and four raises are allowed.
- 9. All other "Texas" Hold'em rules apply.
