HIGH CARD FLUSH PROGRESSIVE

Game Description

High Card Flush Progressive is played using one standard 52-card deck. At the beginning of each game, the player places a standard High Card Flush Ante wager and may optionally place a Flush, Straight Flush and/or High Card Flush Progressive wager. Each player and the dealer then receive seven cards.

The High Card Flush Progressive pays against a paytable if the player is able to create a qualifying hand using their seven cards, even if the player folded their hand on the Ante/Raise wager.

Notes:

- 1. Only the highest qualifying hand is paid.
- 2. The highest result in the paytable awards 100% of the progressive, all other pays are X for 1.
- 3. After 100% payouts are awarded, the meter is reseeded to the initial seed value.
- 4. Casino operators may choose to post a maximum aggregate.
- 5. Casino operators may choose to offer High Card Flush with or without this wager.

Seed Values & Increment

Notes:

- 1. Seed value and payouts must scale with wager size if configured as more than \$1.
- 2. Progressive increments are based on the progressive wager, not the primary wager.
- 3. After 100% payouts are awarded, the meter is reseeded to the initial seed value.
